Aim

1. The aim of this course is to train, prepare and equip, directly appointed officers, with basic soldierly skills and officer like qualities to enable them to accomplish the assigned tasks effectively and efficiently in the Border Security Force.

Duration

2. The course shall be run for a duration of 1+52 weeks (including 01 week zero week). The actual date for commencement of the course shall be notified by BSF HQ in consultation with BSF Academy, subsequently.

Documentation

3. All candidates reporting for the course must be in possession of the following documents: -

- (a) Appointment letter issued by BSF HQrs New Delhi.
- (b) SC/ST/OBC certificate duly issued by competent authority, wherever applicable.
- (c) Date of Birth certificate.
- (b) Original certificates of educational qualification.
- (e) Character certificate from two different Gazetted Officers who are not known to the trainee officer.
- (f) If employed, discharge certificate by the employer, Technical resignation.
- (g) Aadhar Card, PAN Card and cheque book.
- (h) Documents related to Economic weaker section.

Administration

4. (a) **Pay & Allowances**: The salary of the trainee officers, as per extant rules, shall be credited directly into their bank accounts by Pay and Accounts Division BSF, New Delhi, once the official documentation is completed after joining BSF Academy. The candidates are directed to have their bank account opened, preferably, with State Bank of India and multi city cheque book facility. The candidates should get prepared PAN card in their name before joining at BSF Academy. In case, the candidates do not have any bank account at the time of joining BSF Academy, they shall be facilitated for opening of bank accounts. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

General

1. The BSF Academy is located at a distance of appx 32 Kms southwards from Gwalior, at Tekanpur, Distt - Gwalior (MP), along NH - 44 and spread over an area of 2923 acres. There are two railway stations nearby the Academy, Dabra- 12 kms and Gwalior- 32 kms under North Central Division of Indian Railway. All Mail and Express trains halt at Gwalior while some of the trains have stoppage at Dabra, too. There are regular bus services from above two places to Tekanpur.
2. The climate of Tekanpur is hot during summer (April to July) and very cold in winters (Dec to Feb). The monsoon remains active from last week of June to first week of October.

Organization

3. The BSF Academy is headed by the Director, an officer of the rank of Addl DG. The Academy has been organized into the following sub units:-

(a) **Academy HQ**: It comprises of the Director, Jt. Director (Chief-Instructor), Adjutant, Trg Officer, DC (Law) and Deputy Commandant (Trg Store).

(b) **CTSS (Centre for Tactics and Strategic Studies)**: It is headed by an officer of the rank of Inspector General who is responsible for conducting various advanced and in-service courses.

(c) **COT (Center for Officers Training)**: Popularly known as COT, is headed by an officer of the rank of Inspector General and is responsible for conducting basic courses for Assistant Commandant (DE), Assistant Commandant (LDCE), Medical, Veterinary and Engineering Officers, Sub Inspector (DE) & Sub Inspector (LDCE).

(d) **Faculty of Studies (FOS)**: It is headed by a DIG and is responsible for planning, writing and publication of Trg related books/précis and other Force Publications. It also acts as a think tank and Academic Centre for Border/IS duties, strategic planning and management.

(c) **Administrative Wing**: The wing looks after various administrative aspects of the Academy to facilitate smooth trg. It is headed by a DIG as Chief Administrative Officer. The Wing comprises of DC (Prov), Resident Engineer, Mechanical Transport Officer, Accounts Officer and Communication Officer. The Academy has well maintained regimental institutions like Canteen, Cloth Shop, Family Welfare Centre, Gas Agency and Open Theatre.

Besides, the Academy has the following auxiliary units:-

Reception

4. The trainee officers should report at the Academy, 02 days prior to commencement of the course. A reception center will be established near main exit of platform No. 1 at Gwalior Railway Station and all trains arriving at Gwalior Railway Station will be attended to. A detachment of the BSF Academy with civil telephone facility (0751-2340001) is also located outside Gwalior Railway Station, which can be contacted any time for assistance.

Discipline

5. After the commencement of the course, trainee officers will be governed by the BSF Act & Rules for the duration of the course. They are required to adhere to all other written and verbal instructions, orders, code of conduct and norms of the uniform service.

Relegation

6. The Trainee officers can be relegated from the course on the following grounds for various durations extending to next batch:-

- (a) Indiscipline
- (b) Medical Grounds
- (c) Late Arrivals
- (d) Absence from the course, repeated failure in examinations despite sufficient coaching during the relegation period and may be discharged from service in accordance with the BSF Act & Rules, if they are unlikely to become an efficient member of the Force.

Administration

7. (a) **Private Servants**: The trainee officers shall not bring any private servant with them.

(b) **Private Arms**: They will not bring their private arms and ammunition.

(c) **Security**: The trainee officers shall be responsible for the safe custody of their articles. They are advised not to bring valuable items except those required in connection with the training. All pamphlets, précis and classified documents issued during the course of training shall be kept under lock and key. The Academy will not bear any responsibility for loss of any articles in possession of the trainee officer.

(d) **Leave**: No leave except in extreme emergencies shall be granted to the trainee officers during the Course, as it adversely affects the performance and their merit.


