

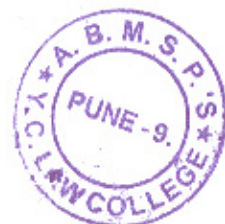

**Report on
Legal Literacy Camp
At Kutwalwadi - Borkarwadi
on 10th February 2018**

The Legal Literacy Camp for the academic year 2017-2018 was organised by the College in collaboration with Board of Students' Development of Savitribai Phule Pune University. The Camp was organised on Saturday, 10th February 2018 at village Kutwalwadi - Borkarwadi, taluka Baramati, district Pune. Fifty seven students and two assistant professors namely Rahul Bibave and Manoj Wanare has participated in the Camp. From the college a common mode of transportation, bus, was arranged for the participants of the Camp. The Camp started with a rally through the village with various socio-legal placards and slogans. The slogans and placards comprised of messages on environment protection, cleanliness, gender equality, human rights and education. The students also performed a street play on women rights. The villagers appreciated the street play with their promising response. The programme of legal literacy started thereafter in the temple of Vitthal-Rukmini located centrally in the village. The programme started with the lighting of lamp at the august hands of the chief guest Adv. Avinash Bharambe, senior advocate, taluka Saswad, district Pune, Mrs. Seema Kutwal, Sarpanch of the village and other dignitaries. LEGAL LITERACY CAMP

At Javalarjun, Tal. Purandar, Dist. Pune

22nd February 2020

To fulfil the social commitment of the College, Yashwantrao Chavan Law College, Pune organises legal literacy camps. The legal literacy camps are arranged at various nearby villages of Pune district, slums, labour colonies and places of needy. With the objects of making the villagers known with their rights and to give them free legal advice for the legal problems faced by them in their life, the College in collaboration and funding of Board of Students Development had organised a legal literacy camp in the village Javalarjun, Tal. Purandur, district Pune. In the said Camp, along with the free legal advice in the villagers the activities like Rally on socio-legal issues, street plays, presentations by the students on contemporary legal issues, lectures by legal luminaries were arranged.

The Camp was participated by 60 students and 2 assistant professor of the College. A bus was arranged for the transportation of the participants.

The bus left for the Camp at 7:15 The Camp was started with the Rally from the Mahila Asmita Bhavan, Javalarjun through the village and back.

The Rally included the slogans on various socio-lagal messages displayed and by the students. After the Rally, the legal literacy programme took place at the Mal Bhavan, Javalarjun. The Programme

started with an introduction and object of the camp by Mr. Rahul Bibave, Assistant Professor of the College. The programme was attended by Sarpanch and all the Panchayat members, social works and other dignitaries from the Village of the Camp and nearby villages. Later, the students delivered speeches on various legal issues viz. Mr. Akshay Khole on various government schemes for agriculture, Mr. Vishal Oval on rights of children and Ms. Uma Korake on Rights of women, Mr. Aniruddha Musale on rights of the senior citizens, Mr. Mahendra Pardeshi on co-operation between police and public. Ms. Kavita Jain compared the programme.

Adv. Avinash Bharambe, Senior Law Practitioner, Saswad delivered speech on Succession Laws and Adv. Satish Rane delivered speech on RTI Act, 2005. The keynote address was given by the chief guest Mr. Ashok Tekawade, former MLA, Govt. of Maharashtra and the presidential address was delivered by Mrs. Sheetal Salunke, Sarpanch, Javalarjun.

The College provided the copies on various laws in simple Marathi versions published by the Maharashtra Legal Services Authority. The College also provided the bunch of application forms for various documents from different government offices and list of various schemes for agriculture and social welfare. The said copies were handed over to the village administration for making them available for the Villagers as and when needed. The programme concluded by the vote of thanks expressed by Mr. Manojkumar Wanare, Assistant Professor of the College.

Guest Lecture - 1

2021-2022

As a part of value addition, the college conducts Guest lecturers in the Yashwantrao Chavan Memorial Law lecture series for giving the students insights in the various legal fields besides the subjects as prescribed in the curricula.

Adv. Yogesh Makhane gave a guest lecture on the subject of 'Procedure of Registration of Document' on the 26 November 2021. Students and faculty members from the legal department were present at the lecture. The purpose of the presentation was to provide an overview of the process of registering documents, focusing on both the legal requirements and the practical aspects of the registration procedure.
