(c) The debate competition on contemporary issues for college students was organized on 18/08/2017. It was participated by 11 teams of students.



| Report 2 | The Covid 19 pandemic seriously affected the educational institutes in respect of teaching learning, co-curricular and extension activities. As a result, teaching learning took place online. The college subscribed to Microsoft Teams for online teaching. Similarly, with the help of the Teams, the college also conducted some more activities during this period.
In order to train the faculty for online teaching, a workshop was conducted |



regarding the use of Microsoft Teams and Google Meet on 11/08/2020 and 4/8/2020 respectively.

Again a separate workshop on online teaching skills was also conducted for the faculty on 29/07/2020.

The eighty percent of the syllabus was covered by way of online classes. The internal assessment was done online.

The college conducted workshops and seminar by way of online platforms.

- Consumerism and Financial Literacy in Covid 19 Times (Seminar)
- Workshop - IPR and Patent Process
- Introduction to Contents of Contract (Seminar)
- National Workshop on New Labour Legislation-Implementation and Challenges
- High Court- Practice, Procedure and Opportunities (Seminar)
- National Workshop on Research Methodology: Approaches and Techniques
- Workshop on How To Get Best Internship in Legal Field

Certain visits to places such the district court and police station could not take place due to the restrictions of the Covid pandemic.

Agenda 3 To appoint teachers for non-law subjects and the unaided section of LLB and LLM courses in the academic year 2021-22.

Report 3 The college appointed three teachers Dr Sadhika Beri, Ms Payal Pawar and Mr Rahul Nikale for Sociology, Economics and Political Science respectively for the academic year, 2021-22. Similarly, another three teachers, Mr Prithviraj Chavan, Mr Raviraj Dhankawade and Ms Rucha Jedhe were also appointed for Law for the same academic year.

Agenda 4 To review online admission and the examination in the academic year 2021-22 in view of the Covid pandemic.

Report 4 Due to the continuous effect of covid pandemic, the college facilitated the online admission process of BALLB III, IV and V and LLB III for this academic year. Admissions of BALLB I and LLB I took place offline through the process of CET.

As far as the examination is concerned, the first semester examination of all classes was conducted online as per the university circular.



Agenda 5 To discuss the issue of online teaching and related issues to it in the first semester of the academic year 2021-22 to the maintenance of quality education.

Report 5 Since the restrictions of the covid pandemic were in force partially, the first semester classes of BALLB III, IV and V and LLB III were held online. However the classes of BALLB I and II and LLB I and II were conducted offline as their first semester of the academic year commenced from February 8. The second semester classes were offline in the traditional manner.

Agenda 6 To discuss the academic activities planned (organizing of guest lectures, revision lectures etc in the first term) and extra-curricular activities such as NSS activities, debate competition, elocution competition, cultural programmes and the others in the first term.

Report 6 The college conducted various academic activities in this academic year.

- National Workshop on National Education Policy 2020: New Horizons of Higher Education and Effective Use of ICT;

- Workshop on Gender Sensitization;

- Workshop on Confidence Building and Motivation;

- IPR Workshop on Understanding Intellectual Property Rights;

- Workshop on Disaster Management;

- Seminar on Economic and Legal Implications of Cryptocurrency.

- The internal assessment which includes tutorials, tests and presentations was completed as per the schedule of the college and the university.

- In order to train students on practical skills of the profession, the client counselling competition was organized on 11 November 2021.

- Guest lectures on Benami Transactions and its Implications and Conveyance.

- The college started a new certificate course, Advocacy and Drafting Skills, as per the guidelines of the university from this academic year.

Agenda 7 To continue the subscription of journals and purchasing of books and if any addition to the existing subscription.

Report 7 The college has continued the subscriptions of national and international journals. The library spent Rs 244013/- on the subscription of journals. Similarly 207 books costing Rs 134646/- have been newly added to the library in this academic



year. In the same year the library subscribed to the database of case laws, Law Finder.

Agenda 8 To take information as to preparation and submission of Annual Quality Assurance Report for 2020-21 to NAAC.

Report 8 The Annual Quality Assurance Report for 2020-21 was submitted on 15/10/2022.

Agenda 9 To apply to BCI for the inspection of the college.

Report 9 The compliance report was submitted to the BCI in April 2022 for further provisional approval to the college. The BCI has granted the provisional approval to the college for 3 sections of BALLB and 4 sections of LLB for 2022-23 to 2024-25. However the non-grant section has been discontinued as the BCI has not extended approval to that section.

Agenda 10 To discuss any other relevant issues raised by the members.

Report 10 The college has been running Spoken English Course for first year students of degree courses. The Course has been renamed as *English Communication Skills* and the syllabus to be revised for 2021-22. The college has also decided to continue Certificate Course for Pre-Law Students as Introduction to Legal Knowledge. The IQAC committee took a decision on commencing a course, Advocacy and Drafting Skills to equip the students with practical skills of legal profession. The committee of senior teachers and lawyers to be appointed to frame the syllabus. The course regarding gender equity is to be considered for 2021-22.

Furthermore the Diploma in Cyber Law is to be continued in collaboration with Asian School of Cyber Law. It was suggested that the courses need to get approved from the university as per the university circular.



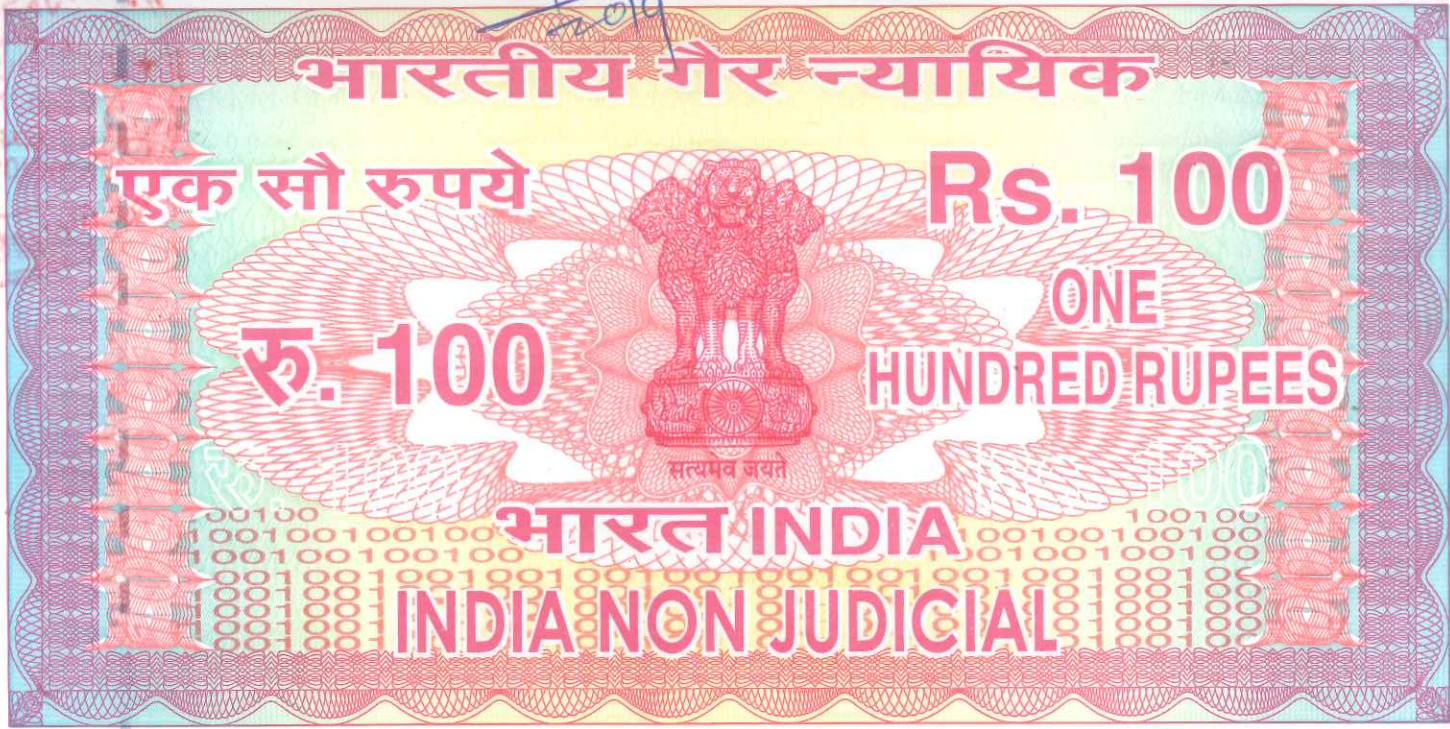

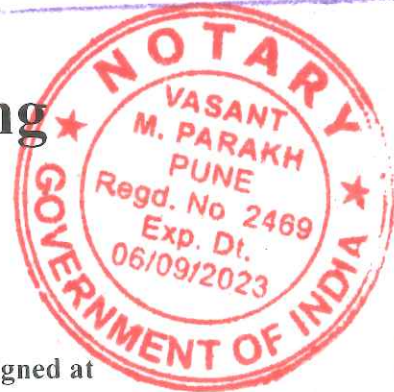

Memorandum of Understanding

Asian School of Cyber Laws, Pune and
Yashwantrao Chavan Law College, Pune
to Conduct Diploma in Cyber Law



This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MOU) is signed at Pune on this 24th day of July 2019 between Yashwantrao Chavan Law College, Pune, hereinafter referred to as YCLC and Asian School of Cyber Laws, Pune, hereinafter referred to as ASCL.

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WHEREAS ASCL has expertise in providing education, training and consultancy in the field of cyber law;
AND WHEREAS YCLC is desirous of providing a quality course named **Diploma in Cyber Law**;

A. Interpretations

Reference to this **MOU** or any other instrument is a reference to this **MOU** or that other instrument as amended, varied, novated or substituted from time to time.

Reference to recitals, clauses, schedules and appendices are references to recitals, clauses, schedules and appendices of and to this **MOU**.

Reference to any statute or statutory provision includes a reference to that statutory provision as from time to time amended, extended, or re-enacted.

Words importing the singular number shall include the plural and vice versa, and words importing the masculine gender shall include the feminine and neuter gender and vice versa, and words importing persons shall include firms, institutions, trusts, societies, associations of persons, companies and bodies corporate and unincorporated, registered and unregistered.

B. Terms of MOU

This MOU embodies the following terms:

I. Name of course and certification

1. ASCL shall jointly conduct the course titled **Diploma in Cyber Law** (hereinafter referred to as DCL) in association with YCLC in online mode.
2. Upon successful completion of the said course, students shall receive certificate for the same issued jointly by YCLC and ASCL.

II. Sale and Distribution of the prospectus and application forms

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1. The distribution of application forms to prospective students of DCL shall be undertaken by YCLC.

All expenses relating to the design and printing of the said application forms shall be borne by ASCL.

III. Eligibility for the course

1. The eligibility for the course in the online mode will be 10+2 with a minimum of 40%. YCLC will conduct the admission process and the same will be given on merit basis.

IV. Collection and distribution of Course Fees

1. The fees for the DCL and the fee sharing between YCLC and ASCL shall be as per **Annexure – II** attached to this MOU.
2. The collection of fees from students will be done by YCLC.
3. ASCL's share (As per Annexure II) of the said fee shall be paid to ASCL by YCLC by way of cheque in favour of "Asian School of Cyber Laws" as per the following schedule:
 - a. 100% of the total amount of ASCL's share will be payable by YCLC within 20 days of the commencement of the course.

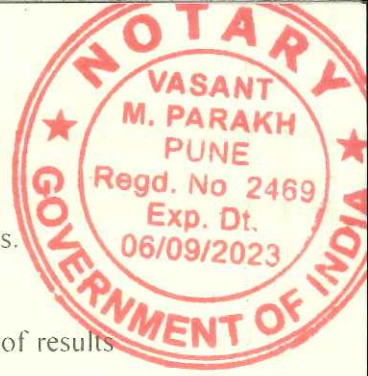
V. Schedule of Course

1. Each batch of DCL in the *online mode* shall begin in the month of August / September and shall be of 6 months' duration. The exact date of commencement shall be mutually agreed upon by the YCLC and ASCL.
2. The Online examination for DCL in online mode shall be held in the month of February / March the following year.

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3. The results for DCL shall be declared within 30 days of the said examinations.
4. The dates of commencement of the Diploma, assessments and declaration of results for each batch are, however, subject to revision after mutual consent by both parties.

VI. Course material

ASCL shall provide online digital learning material to the students enrolled for DCL. All expenses relating to the preparation, updation, and online access of the said material shall be borne by ASCL. The Syllabus of DCL is hereby attached as **Annexure – I** to this MOU.

1. ASCL shall also provide supplementary video content in addition to the aforementioned Diploma material to facilitate holistic learning of the subject.
2. The students will be given access to ASCL ONE (ASCL's Online Education Platform).

VII. Classes

1. ASCL shall conduct 2 online query resolution classes per batch. The exact schedule of query resolution classes for the online course shall be finalized by YCLC and ASCL after considering the convenience of students enrolled for DCL.
2. Students will be expected to send in their queries online in advance. The query resolution classes will be conducted only subject to students submitting their queries in advance (as per schedule decided by YCLC and ASCL).
3. ASCL shall provide the online platform for conducting the classes. The students will be expected to use their mobile devices to access the class online.
 - a. The technical support for this platform will be provided by ASCL.

4. ASCL shall provide expert faculty for conducting the classes of DCL in online mode. All expenses relating to the fee payable to the faculty and traveling incurred by the faculty for conducting the said classes, if any shall be borne by ASCL.

VIII. Assessment Procedure and Certification

1. The assessment for DCL shall consist of one online examination of two hours and 100 marks.
2. ASCL will be responsible for assessment and it may change the assessment pattern as stated above from time to time if required.
3. ASCL shall be responsible for preparing the assessment questions for DCL and shall provide the online question paper for the said assessment.
4. The students may give the exam from any convenient location, which has a stable Internet and Electricity connection.
5. ASCL shall provide the online portal, which the students will be able to access to appear for the examination.
6. A student of DCL, who has been unsuccessful in securing a minimum of 40/100 in the online the examination or has not been able to appear for the examination (for any reason), will be allowed to sit for re-examination only on the payment of a re-exam fee of Rs.1000/- that will be retained by ASCL.
7. The date of re-examination for DCL will be mutually decided by and ASCL.
8. ASCL and YCLC shall jointly grant the certificate to successful students.
9. ASCL shall arrange for certification of successful students of each batch at its own expense and shall courier the certificates to the official address of YCLC. YCLC shall be responsible for distributing the certificates to the successful students.

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IX. Cancellation / Ratification

1. This MOU shall initially be in force for a period of one year, and may thereafter be renewed for such period and on such terms as may be mutually agreed.
2. Either party to this MOU is at liberty to terminate and / or ratify and / or cancel this MOU by giving a prior notice of at least three months.
3. In the event of termination of this MOU before the completion of a batch, both parties shall ensure the successful completion of the course by the said batch.

C. Miscellaneous provisions

1. Force Majeure

If a party is prevented from or delayed in carrying out any provision of this MOU by reason of **Force Majeure**, as defined in the definition clause, the party whose performance is so prevented or delayed, upon prompt notice to the other party, shall be excused from such performance, to the extent and during the period of such prevention or delay.

2. Governing Law

This MOU will be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of India.

3. Arbitration

In case of any dispute etc. both parties agree to attempt arbitration using an independent arbitrator. The decision of such independent arbitrator shall prevail and will be binding on both parties.

The provisions of this clause shall survive the termination of the MOU.

4. Assignment

Neither party shall assign this MOU to a third party without the prior written / electronic consent of the other party.

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5. Variation and Waiver

No variation of any of the terms of the MOU shall be binding unless confirmed in writing or through electronic mail and no failure, delay, relaxation or forbearance on the part of either party in exercising any power or right under this MOU shall operate as a waiver of such power or right.

Failure of a Party to insist upon strict and punctual performance of any provision hereof shall neither constitute a waiver of, or estoppel against asserting, the right to require such performance, nor shall such failure in one case constitute a waiver or estoppel with respect to a later case.

6. Entirety

This MOU is the entire MOU recording the broad understanding between the Parties. Each Party represents that in entering into this MOU it does not rely on any previous representations, whether express or implied, or on any prior inducement or MOU of any kind or nature. All prior negotiations, representations, letters of intent or MOUs concerning the subject matter of this MOU are hereby deemed cancelled.

7. Relationship

Nothing herein shall be deemed to constitute the Parties, or any of them, as partners, association, agent of each other nor shall anything contained herein deem to confer on any Party any authority to incur any obligations or liability on behalf of the other Party nor shall have the power to obligate or bind the other in any way whatsoever, except as provided herein.

8. Miscellaneous

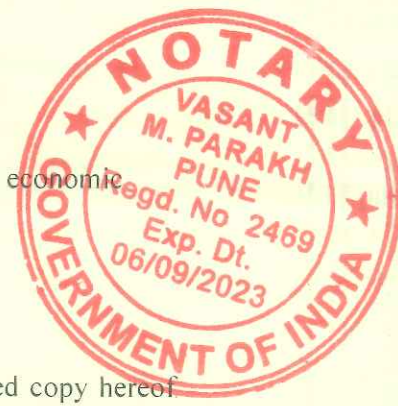
This MOU shall be interpreted, having regard to its underlying business purposes, in a reasonable and commercial manner rather than in strict accordance with the literal meaning of the language used.
